Assignment: Write a 2-2.5 page reaction paper to the first half of *Ebola* (p. 1-65). *Ebola* is written as a piece popular science writing, meaning that it is meant to inform a reader who has a basic knowledge of science. In this instance, the author is seeking to give a historical context and scientific understanding of the ebolavirus.

Follow the specification for reactions papers (found on UBLearns if you don't have your original sheet) and construct your reaction to *Ebola*. After giving a summary of the relevant information of the text through page 65, make 2-3 points about the content of the text.

Things to Consider: What was explained well in the text? How did it change your perceptions? What did would you want to know more about that wasn't explained in the text? What could have been elaborated on more?
